### **Therapeutic Classroom Volunteer Job Description**

This hands-on volunteer opportunity involves giving personal attention to our babies and children in our therapeutic classroom once a week. These special classrooms are often the only place where many of our babies and children feel safe and their environment is predictable.

Volunteers are asked to commit one day a week for three hours. We also need volunteers who are willing to come in when a regular classroom volunteer is not able to attend. All volunteers are given an orientation and ongoing training regarding the relief nursery model, child development, and classroom management. You can be part of a child's development during the most critical period of their life.
